Paramedic Skills Lab I

- I. Demonstrate airway management skills through the use of:
 - A. Basic airways such as oropharyngeal, and nasopharyngeal
 - B. The use of oxygen delivery devices
 - C. Ventilation with bag valve devices
 - D. Intermediate airways such as double lumen devices and laryngeal mask devices
 - E. Advanced airways such as endotracheal tubes
 - F. Surgical airways such as cricothyrotomy
- II. Demonstrate vascular access skills through the use of :
 - A. Peripheral vascular access by angiocath
 - B. Blood collection by angiocath
 - C. Central vascular access by angiocath
 - D. Intraosseous access
- III. Demonstrate medication administration skills by:
 - A. Dermal route
 - B. Subcutaneous route
 - C. Intramuscular route
 - D. Vascular route
 - E. Intraosseous route
 - F. Inhalation route
 - G. Enteral route
