Course Title: Vascular Screening simulation

Prefix and Course Number: VASC 143

Course Description:

The student will be introduced to the clinical environment by spending four weeks in a clinical simulation setting. The students will perform vascular screening procedures on volunteers under the supervision of a qualified vascular technologist. Students will screen for Carotid, Lower Extremity and Abdominal vascular disease.

- Perform limited carotid exams for the evaluation of disease
- Perform ABI and LE exams for the evaluation of PVD
- Perform limited abdominal exam for screening for abdominal aneurysms
- Perform limited vascular screening procedures under supervision
