Course Title: Vascular Clinical III

Prefix and Course Number: VASC 272

Course Description:

Students will practice clinical skills previously developed through active participation in a noninvasive vascular laboratory. This course is a full-time clinical internship and will be completed in an affiliated local or out-of-town hospital. Emphasis of this course is on the clinical skills necessary to the performance and evaluation of all vascular technology examinations. Written reports, review of current literature and attendance at conferences are required.
