COURSE LEARNING OUTCOMES

- 1. Identify verbally and in writing their personal perceptions of discipline, punishment and abuse then compare and contrast their perceptions with the practical, applied and/or legal definitions.
- 2. Demonstrate awareness of media coverage of topics related to child abuse, neglect and family protection and evaluate the underlying reasons the articles were written and published.
- 3. Demonstrate verbally and in writing an understanding of information related to child abuse, neglect and family protection.
- 4. Be familiar with the various agencies that provide services to victims of child abuse, neglect and/or family protection.
- 5. Demonstrate the ability to apply course content concepts including the ability to identify their own emotions; biases and subjective reactions then compare their subjective reactions while making objective assessments and recommendations.
